## What is The FIX Enduro?

The FIX Enduro is a one-of-a-kind RC scale endurance challenge that tests man & machine against nature & time. Whether you choose the 3 Hour Enduro, 6 Hour Enduro, or the legendary 12 Hour Enduro, finishing will require patience, tactics, preparation, endurance, teamwork, and a little luck. The FIX Enduro course is designed to test both driver and machine through realistic terrain, environmental conditions, technical obstacles, and endurance-focused trail driving. **Finishing is winning.**

## RECONG6 Certification Program

Drivers competing in the 12 Hour Certification Classes may earn the coveted RECONG6 Certified Stamp — a validation mark companies can use to demonstrate the durability and capability of their products. This certification is taken seriously. Course design, terrain selection, challenge placement, and endurance requirements are specifically created to realistically test both vehicle and equipment performance under extended real-world scale adventure conditions.

## 3 Hour FIX Enduro Classes

### Adult & Kid Classes\*

- 4200 Solo Class — 1 driver • 1 vehicle • 4.2in / 106mm tire maximum
- 4800 Solo Class — 1 driver • 1 vehicle • 4.8in / 122mm tire maximum
- 5800 Solo Class — 1 driver • 1 vehicle • 5.8in / 147mm tire maximum

### 3 Hour Class Format

Complete as many laps as possible within the 3-hour time limit, plus one final lap before reaching the finish line.

## 6 Hour FIX Enduro Classes

### Adult & Kid Classes\*

- 4200 Solo Class — 1 driver • 1 vehicle • 4.2in / 106mm tire maximum
- 4800 Solo Class — 1 driver • 1 vehicle • 4.8in / 122mm tire maximum
- 5800 Solo Class — 1 driver • 1 vehicle • 5.8in / 147mm tire maximum

### 6 Hour Class Format

Complete as many laps as possible within the 6-hour time limit, plus one final lap before reaching the finish line.

## 12 Hour FIX Enduro Classes

## Adult Classes

- 4200 Solo Class — 1 driver • 1 vehicle
- 4800 Solo Class — 1 driver • 1 vehicle
- 5800 Solo Class — 1 driver • 1 vehicle
- Team Class — 3 drivers • 3 vehicles OR shared vehicle
- Elite Class — Open tire size class

## 12 Hour Class Format

Complete as many laps as possible within the 12-hour time limit, plus one final lap before reaching the finish line.

## Driver Expectations

The FIX Enduro rewards strategy, endurance, patience, scale realism, recovery skill, smart repairs, vehicle preservation, teamwork, and perseverance. This is not a sprint race.

**This is scale endurance adventure.**

## Mandatory Equipment

### Required Equipment

- Tow strap

### Strongly Recommended Equipment

- Sand ladders / recovery ramps
- Spare tire
- Scale recovery equipment
- Trail repair tools
- Batteries & charging equipment
- Weather-appropriate gear

## The Rules of Recovery

### NO HAND OF GOD (“HOGGING”)

Vehicles may not simply be flipped over or repositioned by hand after crashes, rollovers, or recoveries. Recoveries must be performed using a winch, tow strap, assistance from another competitor, or scale recovery techniques.

## Course & Skill Challenges

Terrain may include rock, mud, sand, streams, dirt, wooded trails, elevation changes, and technical obstacles.

Possible challenge sections may include:

- Winching Challenges

- Driver Skill Challenges
- Team Navigation Challenges
- Recovery Challenges
- Driver Only Repair Areas
- Blind Navigation Sections

## Driver Intel

- Drivers must check in every lap.
- The course may feature mandatory recovery or skill sections.

- Driver meetings may include additional operational intel.
- Rules, trail conditions, and challenge requirements may change throughout the event.

**Intel may change.**

All updates, modifications, and operational announcements will be posted or announced during driver meetings throughout the event.
